Unsure of when to secure your wedding vendors? Don't waste any of your precious planning time! Use these tips to work smarter, not harder.

PRREPARATION IS KEY

Leaving your hair and beauty consultations closer to the wedding date is not ideal. Most recommended regimens can require months of repeated use to produce desired results. We recommend 8-12 months of pre-booked appointments to achieve the best possible outcome for your skin, hair and nails.

BOOK WITH THE BEST

Many wedding vendors book out months, and sometimes years, in advance. Once your wedding date is booked or even considered, there is little room for flexibility. Many Brides book their wedding around the availability of their must-have Bridal vendor. Vendors prices will also increase with time, so lock-in that cheaper price early if possible!

BOOK A WELL-TIMED TRIAL

It can be a good idea to book your Hair, Makeup & Tan trial to coincide with your engagement party or prewedding photoshoot to test the longevity, style and comfort while making the most of being all glammed up. However keep in mind that this may not work well due to time constraints - We want to take our time with your trial to get your look just right!

Han Team Checklist

Here are some important questions to ask your vendors before booking and a checklist to keep track of who you are booking with.

- What are their qualifications & experience in Bridal Especially for Hair & Makeup as Bridal is exceptionally different to regular glamour makeup
- Are they a registered business and do they have current Public Liability Insurance?
- Read and research recent reviews to hear what other Brides have to say about their experience.
- Do they have a contingency plan if they can't provide booked services due to illness or emergency?

The Best Hair Day

Your best hair day is all about preparation. Cutting, colouring and nourishing can take months to see results and give you the desired effect.

NUTRIENTS



Your hair reflects your health! Drinking water and eating vitamin-rich foods are a must for healthy hair & skin.

EVERY 1-2 MONTHS 1" TRIMS



See your hairdresser every 4-6 weeks for regular trims to keep your hair healthy, split-end free and help promote hair growth.

6 MONTHS BEFORE WEDDING COLOUR



Discuss colour options with your hairdresser.

Having highlights can help add dimension, show movement in your hair and can help it hold style for longer on the day. (You may need a colour touch up closer to the day)

3 MONTHS BEFORE WEDDING

TRIAL



Come to your trial prepared with at least 2 different styles. Not every style will work for your hair type. Discuss with your stylist if hair extensions are required to make your dream look come to life! Just like an Instagram filter on a picture of makeup, extensions are used frequently in inspiration pictures

WEDDING DAY

IT'S HERE!



Wash your hair the day before your wedding and follow the product prep instructions given to you by your stylist at the trial!



Although you are more than deserving of quite a few glasses of champagne on your Wedding Day, keep in mind that drinking alcohol may hinder hair growth by dehydrating the hair, making it brittle and prone to breakage. Try to limit alcohol consumption in the months leading up to your big day to ensure long, luscious and strong locks of hair!

Your flawless makeup starts with perfectly prepared skin. Consistency is key when it comes to beautiful skin!

NUTRIENTS



Your skin reflects your health! Drinking lots of water and eating vitamin-rich foods are a must for healthy hair & skin.

1 YEAR BEFORE WEDDING

COSMETIC TREATMENTS



See your Beauty Therapist to start making a yearplan for laser hair removal and facial treatments. See your Nurse/Doctor about cosmetic enhancement procedures like botox or fillers.

8 MONTHS BEFORE WEDDING

ROUTINE



Book a skin analysis with your Beauty Therapist to assess any skin concerns and get the right products for your skin routine.

6 MONTHS BEFORE WEDDING

BROWS



Consult a brow artist and have your brows professionally shaped and continue working with them until 2 weeks prior to your wedding for your last appointment.

1 MONTHS BEFORE WEDDING

FINAL PREP



Your final facial treatment should be done this month. Also book your trial spray tan. Now is the time to reduce alcohol intake and not try any new skincare products to reduce the risk of break outs.

2 WEEKS BEFORE WEDDING

WAXING



No waxing after this point to ensure your skin looks its best, also book your nails within this fortnight. Wear sunscreen everyday to avoid any sun damage to the skin.



Although you are more than deserving of quite a few glasses of champagne on your Wedding Day, keep in mind that drinking alcohol can cause dehydration in your skin and lead to signs of premature ageing. So drink sparingly leading up to the big day and always have plenty of water and anti-oxidant rich foods to compensate!

Wedding Countdown - 1 to 4 Months

The next 4 months are critical to ensuring your skin and hair perform their best for your big day! You've put in all the hard work, don't slow down now!

- Your Beauty Therapist may suggest a cosmetic peel or microdermabrasion for your next couple treatments
- Your Hairdresser may suggest to add some highlights over your next 2 appointments to help give your hair dimension
- Consult with your Hairstylist about extensions and order them now so they arrive in time for the trial and for you to take to your hairdresser to colour-match

- Last haircut & treatment with Hairdresser
- Last pre-wedding appointment with Cosmetic Nurse
- Touch base with Hair & Makeup Artist to advise of any changes from Hair & Makeup Trial

Your troubleshooting guide for our most commonly heard beauty complaints and frustrations

HAIR DOESN'T HOLD CURL & LOOKS FLAT

Are you buying your shampoo & conditioner at the supermarket? Stop now! Salon quality products are key to nourishing your hair and ensuring less build up on the hair. When hair has mineral or silicone build up, it can be extremely difficult to style with heat.

Try **Paul Mitchell Extra Body Shampoo** to fully cleanse any build up and give you lift at the root. Available at <u>jessicavegas.com</u>

For extra stubborn hair, some foil highlights at your next salon appointment can help dry the hair out and make it a little more cooperative in holding style and body.



LASHES HAVE IRRITATED IN THE PAST

Have you had difficulty tolerating lashes in the past? Do you have a latex sensitivity or allergy? A lot of lash glues on the market are latex-based and this can cause irritation to the eye, even once the glue is dry. Make sure to mention to your artist if this has happened previously.

All of our artists carry Latex-free glue to accomodate all client needs. Our favourite latex-free lash glue is **ModelRock**, which Jessica stocks



EYES WATER ALL DAY

Did you know that watery eyes can be a sign of dry eye? If you stare at a screen all day for work, you may not be blinking as effectively or often as you think you are. It can also be a sign of irritation from product with SPF getting into your eye throughout the day.

For temporary relief, try some eye drops from your optometrist. My favourite are **Systane Ultra** fresh out of the fridge for extra relief.



PINTREST-WORTHY HAIR

Ever noticed how influencers and those inspo pictures you've found all look like they have the most incredible hair? The secret is extensions. 9/10 the model is wearing extensions in pictures brides show me of how they want their hair. A lot more affordable and easier to maintain than traditional weft or tape, clip-in extensions are a fabulous option for your big day.
